Minutes of Members Meeting – 17th September 2022

1. <u>Introduction:</u> Vanda welcomed members, especially those who were new to the Network. Vanda said a few words about Queen Elizabeth II, followed by a minute's silence. The meeting continued with a talk and presentation by Koen Van Der Straeten, general manager of the Brock Garden and Craft Centre, Strathbrock Partnership, Broxburn. Koen detailed the history of the Brock Garden Centre and its present role as a charity and social enterprise, which provides therapeutic horticulture, woodwork and craft activities for those experiencing chronic mental health conditions. The plants grown and the craft items made are sold and the proceeds go towards delivering activities. Koen was thanked for an interesting talk and members requested that a collection be taken for the Brock. The sum raised was £70. Koen has kindly offered to donate a floral prize for next month's raffle.
