## MEMBERS' MEETING – $19^{TH}$ NOVEMBER 2022

- 1. **Our Speaker** this month was Philip Dodsworth from Blood Bikes Scotland who gave a most interesting talk about the free service the Blood Bikes give to the NHS by carrying small items from hospital to hospital; items which are often important even urgent.
- 2. <u>Holidays and trips</u> Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2023 Rosslyn Chapel followed by a tour of the Parliament building. Departs Bathgate Railway Station at 10.am. Rosslyn was founded in 1446 and services continue to be held here weekly. Its popularity greatly increased with the publication of Dan Brown's novel, the Da Vinci Code in 2003. The trip then transfers to the Scottish Parliament building where there is time for lunch before a tour of the building. This will take approximately 45 minutes, then the group will be given the opportunity to explore the public gallery and the exhibition. Tickets on sale at the hub from Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> November cost £22.50.
