This charity places boxes in strategic places where the general public might contribute toiletry items: soaps, shampoo, deodorant etc. This gives people who can't afford these items the opportunity to take the items for free and still retain their dignity.

Isobel identified this need when she worked as a health professional and was so moved when she witnessed such poverty that she came up with the idea of providing the necessary items, thus allowing the users to help themselves and keep their dignity.

A donation bucket was passed round and came up with £80.
