Awareness Sessions

Thursday 2nd May: a representative from West Lothian Council Advice Shop came along to talk about any payments that older people may be entitled to.

It is worth noting that the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) estimates that £1.7 billion of Pension Credit went unclaimed by pensioner households in financial year 2021/22. In West Lothian alone it is estimated that £5,606,926 of Pension Credit went unclaimed. Furthermore, eligibility for Pension Credit unlocks a range of other support including help with energy and council tax.

The Advice Shop is able to meet with individuals in one-to-one sessions to check their eligibility.
