Community Engagement



The Network was out in force at the Bathgate Fun Day, hosted by Link at Creamery Park.

Our team of volunteers were on hand throughout the day to chat with locals about the Network's groups, trips, and wellbeing activities and plenty of new faces stopped by to find out more.

Our Charity Manager Jamie also took the chance to connect with Graham from Home Instead West Lothian this month. The two discussed the great work both organisations are doing to support older adults and shared ideas on how they might collaborate on future projects.

The Network continues to support efforts to safeguard the café at Rosemount Gardens, recognising how valued it is by local older people. We've been working in the background to help facilitate discussions and explore possible long-term solutions, including the idea of a community-led model that keeps the café running and serving local needs. The café remains open for now, with the future of the service still under discussion. The Integration Joint Board (IJB), which oversees health and social care in West Lothian, is expected to meet again on 13th August to consider next steps.

We're continuing to engage with council officers, local partners, and community members to ensure that any future plans take into account the needs of older people across the area.
