We're pleased to confirm a new partnership with West Lothian Foodbank as they establish their Bathgate Distribution Centre. While their long term base at St David's Church is under refurbishment, we're providing temporary space in our Members Hub so their service continues without interruption. This keeps vital support close at hand for individuals and families in Bathgate and strengthens the wider network of help available across the community.

Network vice chair Sheila Jamieson, and one of our new Network Ambassadors, Karene Sutherland, represented the Network at the recent Carers Rights Day. This annual event plays a key role in making sure carers know what support is open to them. The theme this year, Know Your Rights, Use Your Rights, centred on giving carers clear information, practical guidance and direct access to professionals. The drop in session at Strathbrock Partnership Centre offered strong advice on legal rights, financial support, community services, social care and more. It was a welcoming and well run event, and we were pleased to be represented and continue building our links with partners supporting carers across West Lothian.

## **Volunteer Spotlight**


